The UK Prime Minister, David Cameron, announces with a letter to the Financial Times that he will give a crunch to emigrants asking for unemployment benefit rights.

Cameron is worried about a huge migratory flux from Bulgaria and Romania, starting from the next January, when there won't be any border restrictions.

Cameron's complaints are about people's freedom of movement in the European Union, which he would limit due to a given "tourism for benefits".

In the statements in The Mirror, he disapproved the Labour Party's "monumental mistake" that has allowed people from eastern European countries to immigrate into

Despite his mainstream reticence to communitarian integration, the Tory Party has been afraid to be overwhelmed by Nigel Farage's right wing party, the UKIP, the British anti-Europe power politics, during the next European political elections in 2014. The UKIP's leader, in fact, hasn't lost the opportunity to criticise the PM – according to the Huffington Post – claiming early authorship against the immigration. The Office for National Statistics has issued the quarterly report about immigration statistics today.

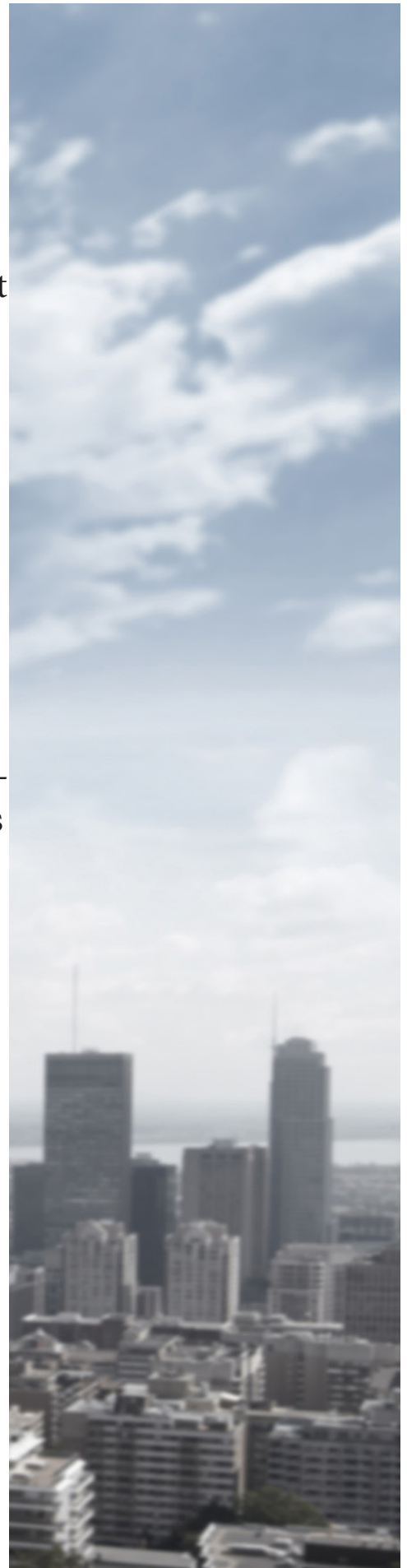
It reveals that the number of immigrants has been reduced in the last year: from 517 000 to 503 000 people.

The emigration is at the lowest level since 2001. The net flow of 182 000 long-term migrants to the UK has risen 8.2%, in a year (it was 167000 in June 2012).

The leaping out amount is the decrease of immigration flow from non-EU citizens (40000 people less in a year), and the increase of EU15 citizens arriving in the UK for work-related reasons and in September 2013 there was an increase in the number of working-visas.

The EU Commissioner of Internal Affairs, Cecilia Malmstrom, has expressed her opinion of this growth of intolerance. Freedom of movement is a fundamental right in the European Union and it's safeguarded by the European Commission and they will take a hard look that everything will be proposed, she said.

According to an interview at the BBC, Laszlo Andor, European Commissioner for Employment, has reproached London to avoid hysteria, claiming that the actual truth about the immigration advantages is not known to the British people.
